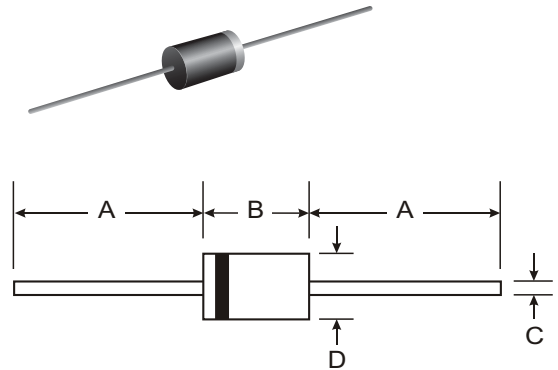

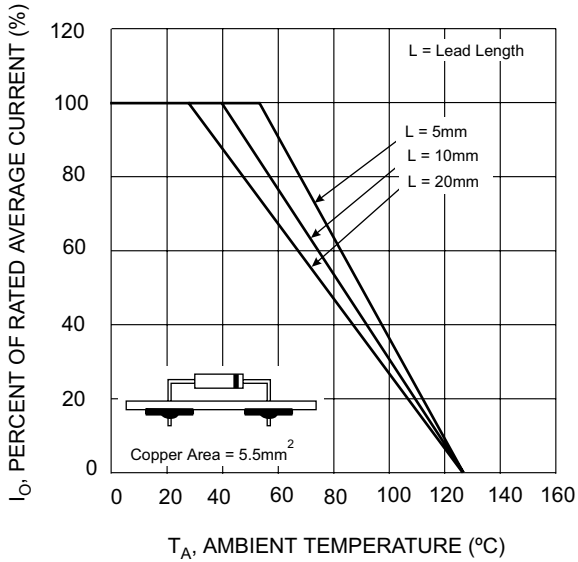


Fig. 1 Current Derating for Various Lead Lengths

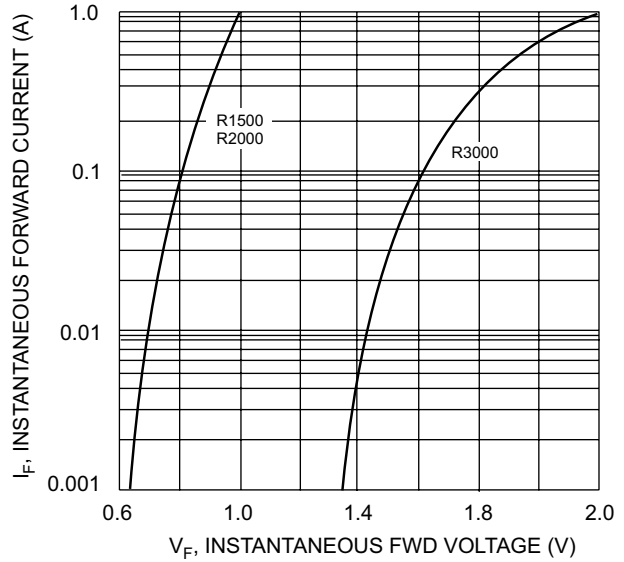


Fig. 2 Typical Forward Characteristics

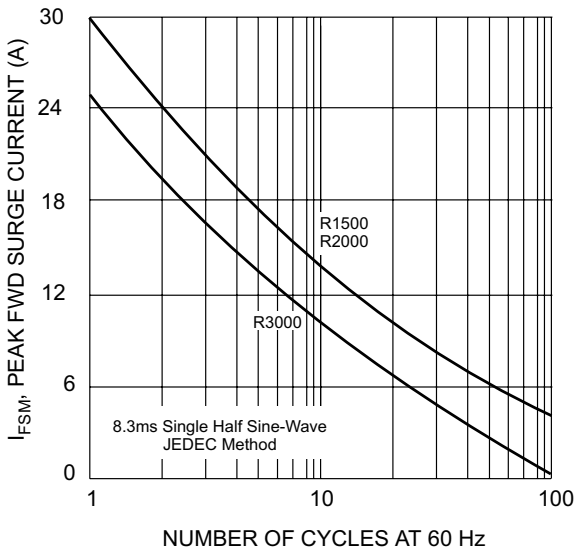


Fig. 3 Peak Fwd Surge Current vs # of Cycles @ 60 Hz

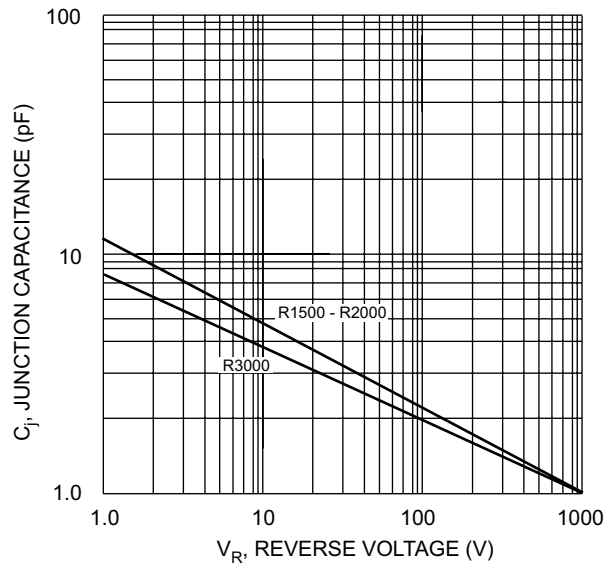


Fig. 4 Typical Junction Capacitance
